Details regarding the services available at the Center for Reading at Pittsburg State University

EVALUATION SERVICES

- **Comprehensive Evaluation.** The first step in the treatment of reading difficulties is appropriate identification. Our most popular evaluation comprehensively examines the individual's current reading and attentional skills. Our assessment battery includes an assessment of reading and spelling, an objective test of attention, a nonverbal measure of intelligence, ratings of social-emotional behavior, and a hearing screening. Results can be used to inform appropriate interventions at our center or shared with others.
- **Reevaluation.** The reading skills of individuals receiving intervention in our program are periodically reevaluated to measure progress.
- **Attention and Impulse-Control Evaluation.** Our gold standard assessment of attention and impulse control involves objective testing as well as ratings of relevant behavior. Results can be taken to a physician or other qualified professional for diagnosis. We do not provide medical or psychiatric diagnoses.
- **Titration Monitoring.** For individuals using medication to help manage symptoms of inattention and hyperactivity, we offer titration monitoring. This involves periodic assessment and score comparisons to help determine whether treatment is improving attentional functioning. Results can be taken to the prescribing provider. We do not prescribe medication.

INSTRUCTION AND INTERVENTION

- **Weekly Intervention.** You or your child is paired with a Center for Reading interventionist who will provide individual tutoring services in the areas of reading in which you or your child is struggling. Re-evaluations are completed periodically to determine progress. Our interventionist coordinator will schedule intervention during a time and day of the week that works best for you. This type of intervention can occur in person or online. Sessions can be 30 to 60 minutes and can take place once per week, twice per week, or every other week. The fee scale is below.
- **Intensive, Week-Long Intervention.** You or your child visits the Center for Reading every day for one week (Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.). For approximately six hours a day, different interventionists will deliver reading tutoring in the areas of reading in which you or your child is struggling. During the last hour on Friday, a reevaluation is completed to measure progress. This type of intervention occurs in-person only. A deposit is required at the time of scheduling and the remaining fees are paid on the first day of intervention. The schedule and fee scale are below.
- **Summer Instruction and Intervention: Secret Codes Camp.** Students attend camp for approximately one hour per day Mondays through Thursdays during June and July. Students meet in small groups for eight weeks (32 sessions total). Efforts are made to group students based on their age and reading skills. Students are assessed at the beginning and end of the summer to measure their progress. Secret Codes Camp is offered onsite or online. The fee for Secret Codes Camp is \$500 per student (\$100 for materials and \$400 for tuition).
